Quilt Block Pillow:

Class 1: any design
pieced

Class 2: any design
appliquéd

1. Pillows must be no larger than 18" square, maximum size finished and stuffed.
2. Ruffling or piping on edges to finish is optional and will not be judged.
3. Can use the fabric, thread and design of your choice.
4. All pillows will be judged at Subordinate/Pomona level, first place winner to be judged at State level.
5. All blocks/pillow tops must be done by hand. No machine quilting or embroidering.
6. Entries will be judged on design, workmanship and general appearance.

Quilt Contest:

Division A - Quilts
minimum 60" X 60"
maximum 120" X 120"

Class 3: Quilts entirely hand
quilted by an
individual

Class 4: Quilts
entirely hand quilted
by a group

Division B – Baby Quilt

Class 5: Hand quilted

Class 6: Machine quilted

Division C – Wall Hanging, maximum 48" X 48"

Class 7: Hand quilted

Class 8: Machine quilted

Division D – Quilts

Class 9: Machine quilted

1. No pre cut quilt kits. No tied quilts.
2. Quilted items must contain batting. You may use any brand quilt batting that you choose.
3. All quilt contest items in all four Divisions are to be sent to State Session for judging.
No Subordinate or Pomona elimination is necessary for this contest.
4. Entries will be judged on workmanship, general appearance, and suitability of article for purpose.

Baking/Cooking Contest:

Class 10: Dessert Bread

(pumpkin only)

Class 11: Molasses

Cookies

Class 12: Fudge

Rocky Road

1. Place 8 pieces of fudge (approx. ½ lb.) 6 cookies (decorated or plain or 1 full size loaf of bread (approx. (8" X 3" X 3")) NO mini loaves, on a disposable plate in a Ziploc bag or in a disposable plastic container.

2. Tape the recipe to the bottom of the container, all classes.

3. Entries will be judged on uniformity, texture, and taste.

4. After judging, entries may be used in a sale or donation of some type for the Family Activities Committee.

Afghan Contest:

Class 13: Full size (minimum

size 42" X 55")

Class 14: Baby Afghan

(maximum size

45" X 45")

1. Afghans can be knitted or crocheted with any brand of yarn you choose. NO machine work.

2. Entries will be judged on workmanship, suitability of article to purpose, and general appearance.

In case of a tie, the level of difficulty will determine the winner.

Embroidery, Crewel, Plastic Canvas:

Class 15: Embroidery

Class 16: Counted Cross

Stitch

Class 17: Plastic Canvas

Needlepoint

1. Class 15 is any item except counted cross stitch, using any brand floss you desire.

2. Class 16 is only counted cross stitch items using any brand floss you desire.

3. You may use any brand of yarn you choose for Class 17.

4. Entries will be judged on workmanship, general appearance and suitability of article to purpose.

Cotton Crochet Thread Contest:

Class 18: Doilies/

Centerpieces

1. May be crocheted, knitted or tatted with any brand of cotton crochet thread you choose.

2. Entries will be judged on workmanship, suitability of article to purpose and general appearance.

Fabric Table Runners:

Class 19: Any size

1. Sewn from the pattern and fabric of your choice.
2. Must have a backing or lining on them.
3. Decorations of your choice.
4. All work must be done by the entrant. NO professional seamstress accepted.
5. All work must be done by hand or machine.
6. Entries will be judged on appearance, workmanship and creativity.

Snowman:

Class 20: Snowman

Fabric

Class 21: Snowman

Ceramic

Class 22: Snowman

Wood (any finish)

1. Maximum size is 18" high.
2. Base Maximum size is 18" X 18".
3. All work must be done by the entrant.
4. Finish and decorate to your choice.
5. No kits may be used in class 20 and 22.
6. Entries will be judged on workmanship, general appearance and suitability of article to purpose
7. Articles cannot be purchased at craft sale/shows, or from books and used to enter.

Vests:

Class 23: Vest for men or

women

1. Sewn from the pattern of your choice or a homemade pattern.
2. Made from Fabric and lining of your choice.
3. Decorations of your choice, if desired.
4. All work must be done by hand or machine.
5. NO Professional seamstresses permitted.
6. Article must be on a hanger for judging.
7. Entries will be judged on appearance, workmanship, and suitability of article to purpose.

Quilt Blocks:

Class 25: Pieced

Log Cabin

Pattern

Class 26: Applique

Wish Upon a Star

Pattern

1. Class 25 must be 14-1/2 " X 14-1/2" completed square, which includes 1/4" seam allowance.
2. Class 26 must be 12-1/2" X 12-1/2" completed square, which includes 1/4" seam allowance

3. **Must use the designated patterns and color scheme as directed on the pattern.**
4. Must be 100% cotton
5. Wash fabric before using to control bleeding and shrinkage.
6. All blocks are to be sent to State Session for judging. Subordinate and Pomona elimination is not necessary.
7. Blocks WILL NOT be returned. They will be used by the FA for future quilts.
8. Entries will be judged on workmanship, creativity and general appearance.

Decorate a Tea Cup:

Class 27: Tea Cup and

Saucer, standard

size

1. Finished overall size maximum 8" X 8".
2. You create the design to suit your cup and saucer.
3. Entry will be judged on workmanship, creativity, and appearance.
