

## The Grange Scholarship Endowment at the Pennsylvania State University

\* The purpose of this scholarship shall be to provide recognition to outstanding undergraduate students enrolled in at least their sophomore year at any College or campus of the Pennsylvania State University who have a demonstrated need for funds to meet their necessary college expenses.

\* The Endowment provides for an annual \$1500 scholarship.

\* Consideration for this scholarship shall be given to full-time undergraduate students enrolled in at least their sophomore year at any College or campus of The Pennsylvania State University who are members of the Grange in good standing, who have achieved superior academic records, and who have a demonstrated financial need.

\* Recipients of this scholarship shall be selected by the Office of Student Aid Scholarship Committee. Nominations shall be solicited from the Pennsylvania State Grange Scholarship Committee which is the sole method of identifying students who are Grange members.

\* The annual scholarship shall be awarded for one academic year and may be renewed for subsequent years providing the recipient continues to meet the conditions of eligibility, funds are available and no other eligible students are identified.

\* Deadline for applications is May 1. Applications are available at the State Grange office.

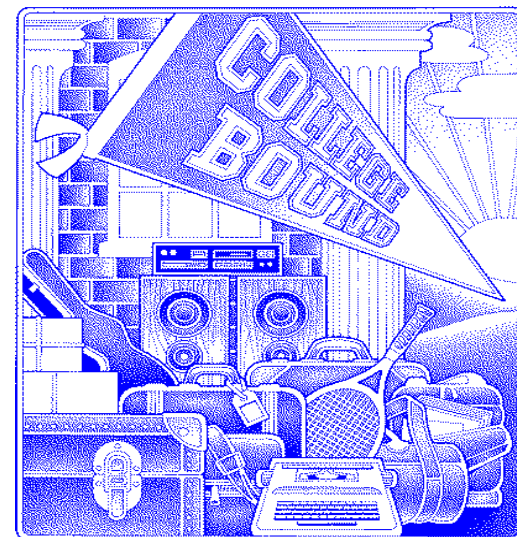

## **PA State Grange Foundation Programs**

### **PA State Grange Foundation Scholarship**

- \* The Grange Foundation Scholarship was established by delegate action in 1996. Candidates must be Fourth Degree Grange members in good standing for at least one year prior to applying. They must seek higher education in any field at any institution of higher learning and be in need of financial assistance.
- \* Eligible applicants shall be entering their junior or senior year in college and may not receive the scholarship more than twice. The scholarship is a grant of \$500, with no repayment required. More than one grant may be awarded per year, depending on the income available from the fund.
- \* The Selection Committee consists of the State Grange Overseer, one member of the State Grange Executive Committee and three appointed Grange members, at least one of whom is an educator. The Foundation Scholarship Fund is administered by the PA State Grange Executive Committee.
- \* Deadline for applications is May 1 of each year. Applications are available at the State Grange office.

### **Deaf Interpreter Scholarship**

- \* This \$250 scholarship shall be awarded to a student enrolled in a credible program leading to certification as a qualified interpreter for the deaf.

## **Leonard Rhone Scholarship Fund**

- \* The scholarship program was initiated in memory of Leonard Rhone, third Master of the Pennsylvania State Grange.
- \* A \$300 grant will be available each year. To be eligible, a student must pursue a four-year study in agriculture or home economics (a.k.a. Human Development and Family Services) at Penn State University.
- \* The student recipient of this grant must be a Grange member in good standing and be endorsed by the Master of his or her Subordinate Grange and Pomona Grange.
- \* Applications are available at the State Grange office and must be completed by May 1 for those enrolling in the fall term.



## **Santee Student Loan Fund**

- \* The Santee Student Loan was established by the late Ellis M. Santee, a country doctor from Shickshinny and an active Grange member.
- \* This student loan consists of a \$500 per year loan, interest free, to Grange members or their children.
- \* All loans are given on the basis of a written “repayment” promise. You must notify the State Grange Treasurer of repayment plans within six months of graduating, leaving school or ceasing to be a full-time student. All loans must be repaid within three years of the repayment start date.
- \* Students receiving this loan can reapply each year they are enrolled as a full-time student, with a maximum of four loans to any one individual. Loans will be granted for undergraduate studies only, except in the case of medical students which may be considered on a case-by-case basis under the rules of the Santee Trust agreement.
- \* The Selection Committee consists of the State Grange Ceres, Pomona, Flora and Treasurer. The student loan is administered by the State Grange Master and Executive Committee. Checks will be payable to the student and college.
- \* Applicants must furnish the State Grange office the person’s name who will co-sign the loan note.
- \* Applications are available at the State Grange office and must be completed by May 1 for those enrolling in the fall term. The application date is Sept. 1 for students enrolling in the spring term.
