

The PA State Grange Foundation Scholarship

Established in 1996 by delegate action, this scholarship is available to any Grange member, in good standing, entering their Junior or Senior year in college.

Candidates should be in need of financial assistance and may be studying any subject at any institute of higher learning.

Each applicant is eligible to receive a \$500 grant each year, for a maximum of two years. More than one grant may be awarded in any given year, depending on the amount available in the fund.



Deadline - May 1

Deaf Interpreter Scholarship

The PA State Grange has had a long relationship with the deaf community. This scholarship is just one way that we continue to support programs that assist the deaf and hard of hearing.

Applicants must be a Grange member in good standing and be enrolled in a credible program leading to certification as an interpreter for the deaf.

Each year a \$250 grant will be awarded to the best applicant.

Deadline - May 1

Rhone Scholarship

Leonard Rhone was the third Master of the PA State Grange, this scholarship is given in his name to honor the great things he did for the Grange.

This scholarship is only available to those pursuing a degree in agriculture of human development & family services at Penn State University. One scholarship in the amount of \$300 will be available each year.

Eligible candidates must be a member in good standing and secure a recommendation from both the Master of their Subordinate and Pomona Granges.

Deadline - May 1

Santee Student Loans

Ellis M. Santee was an active Grange member and country doctor who knew the importance of a good education. This loan fund was established by the late doctor to help young members get that education.

An interest free loan of \$500 will be given to a Grange member or their child, who meets the criteria. Recipients can reapply each year they are enrolled as a full time student. A maximum of four loans might be given to any one individual.

A written repayment promise is required, and should be submitted to the State Grange within six months of graduating. Repayment must be completed within three years of the repayment plan start date.

Deadline - May 1

The Grange Scholarship Endowment at Penn State University

This scholarship is to recognize the outstanding work of an undergraduate student enrolled in at least their sophomore year at any campus of Pennsylvania State University who also demonstrates financial need.



The recipient of this scholarship will be selected by the Penn State Office of Student Aid Scholarship Committee from nominees named by the PA State Grange Scholarship committee. This is the sole method to be used to identify students who are Grange members.

The \$1500 scholarship will be awarded for one academic year and may be renewed for subsequent years providing the recipient continues to meet the conditions of eligibility and no other eligible students are identified.
