What's new?

- How can we adjust for this new normal and continue to run our programs?
- Our youth and juniors need to have a purpose and incentive to get on/participate, especially in a zoom or virtual event
 - i.e. Photo contest, leaders need to help push participation
- How to avoid zoom burnout?
- New guidelines – outdoor events seem to be better to conduct in person, try to keep as many events outdoors as possible,
- Burnout already happening, people opting to do other things that they can in person and folks are not so desperate for that connection
- More community service projects, outside events, highway pick up, look for more community service projects around local area
 - Road rally
 - 150 acts of service/kindness
 - Bucket gardens, donated buckets, filled with soil, planted seeds and then sold them for \$5 to folks in the community
- Food truck fundraiser, maybe at state session, encourage attendees and outside folks to attend/purchase – ask hotel if we can have a food truck and find out with the food truck how we would make money
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
